

## Calf Club Day Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> October 2015

Calf Club Day this year will be held on Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> October. There are several options to ensure that all Glenbrook School children can participate and celebrate in the rural nature of our school. Each category will need to be officially entered. Entry forms are at the office and in upcoming newsletters.

- Obtain, care for and raise a lamb, calf or kid and then proudly demonstrate all the hard work done in the rings. Information booklets on what the animal and child need to do are available at the office. No poster is required for this category.

OR

- Raise and care for a day old chicken that you can order from the office. Because of snow camp at the end of August, we have had to choose an earlier date. Order by **Friday 3rd July**. \$6 each. Information booklets are at the office on how to build a brooder house and care for your chick. A poster is required and worth 50% of your mark. Chicks will arrive at school on Friday 14th August.

OR

- Bring your dog, horse or small furry to CCD. Dogs will do a small obstacle course and be judged. Small furies and horses will just be judged. Information booklets are at the office and you will need to do a poster worth 50% of your mark.

OR

- The PTA option for this year's CCD is a grass seed head creature. Let your imagination run wild. Free grass seed is available at the office from next week. There will be a junior and senior category. No poster is required. **Do not bring entries to school before Term 4 Week 1 (week of Calf Club).**

OR

- The garden option for this year is to grow your own potatoes in a bucket. Free seed potatoes will be available from the office next week. All children must use the seed provided. A poster will be required of your efforts and be worth 50% of your final mark. **Do not bring entries to school before Term 4 Week 1 (week of Calf Club).**
